

ALUMNI REPORT 2010



The Career Development Center (CDC) every year surveys new alumni 7 months after they graduate to determine whether new graduates are employed, engaged in further studies, whether graduates returned to their home country or are working, studying abroad.

CDC was able to obtain information from **94%** (99 out of 105 graduates) of the 2010 graduating class, combining December 2009 and May 2010 graduates.

The LCC graduates of 2010 come from nine different countries. LCC provides a unique learning environment. Due to innovative and interactive teaching methods and engaging Student Life programming, LCC students have an opportunity to develop excellent leadership, problem solving, communication skills and have the ability to think critically and take responsibility for their decisions. LCC prepares its graduates to pursue careers in both business and academic world.

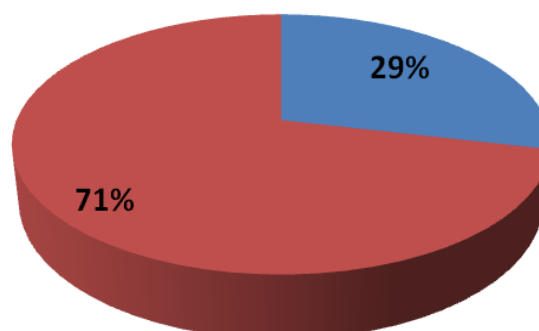

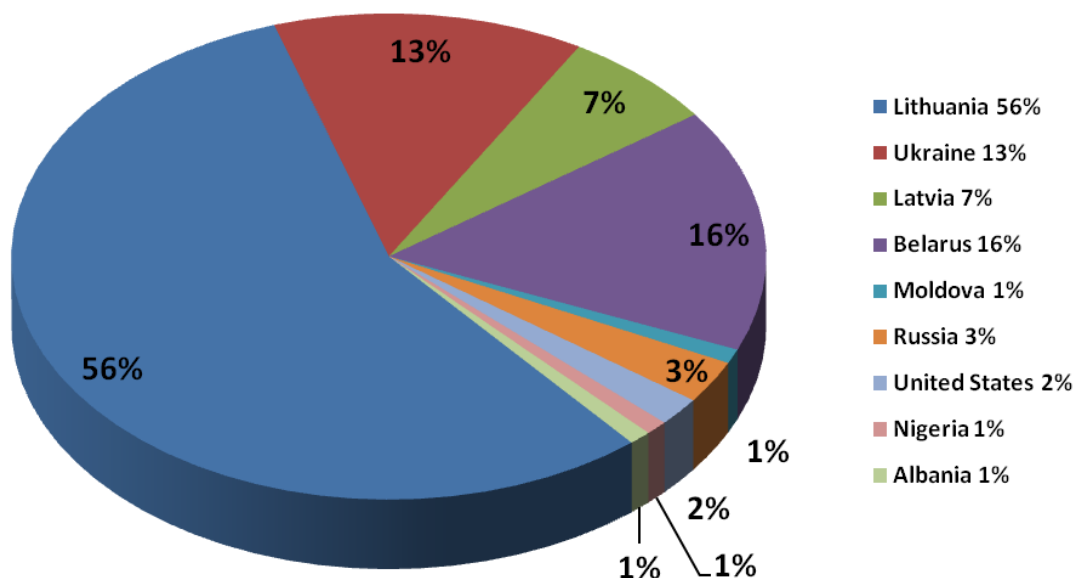

Gender proportion

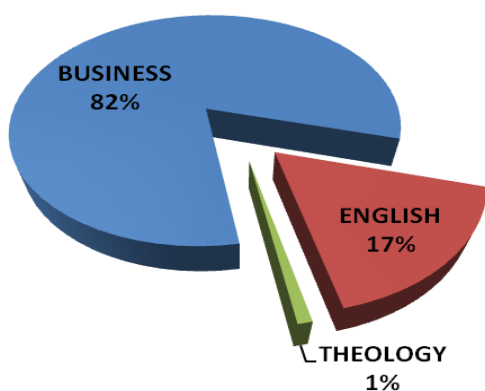
■ MALE ■ FEMALE

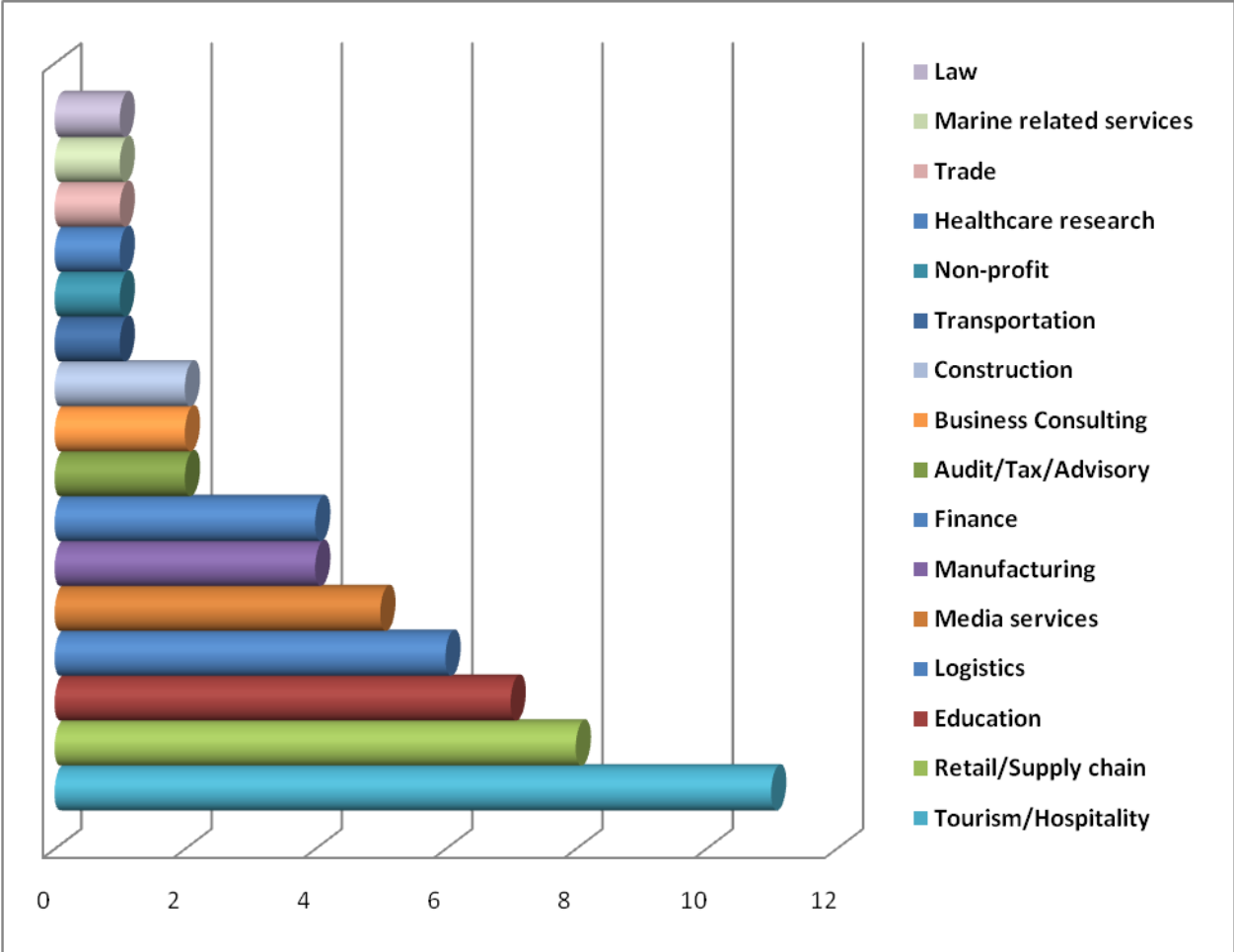

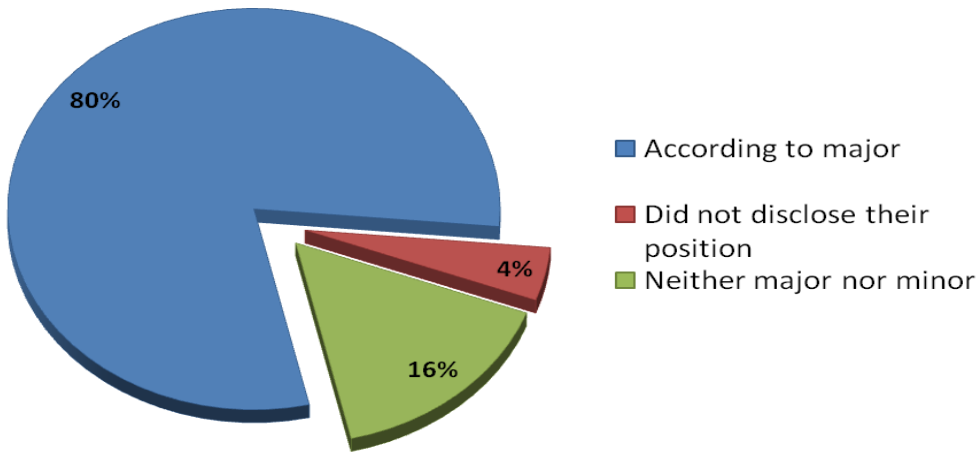
